Safety Services New Brunswick's one-day **Arboricultural Electrical Safety Course** (known as *Green Card*) meets the requirements of current legislation and the New Brunswick Power Corporation tendering process. The entire program is in layman's terms, presented in a format of videos, powerpoint and group discussion.

Candidates are required to pass a written/oral Qualification Test (75%) demonstrating their knowledge and skills and a certificate with a 3-year expiry will be issued after successful completion.

This program prepares those working near power structures, such as transmission and distribution lines, to protect their safety and the health and safety of other workers.
