Course Format

Safety Services New Brunswick offers a ½ day **Pole Top Rescue Course**. Participants will receive knowledge and skills by use of classroom instructions and practical exercise.

Course Objectives

This course was developed to provide the participant the proper techniques of performing a Pole Top Rescue.

Course Outline

- Reasons individuals become pole top rescue candidates
- The importance of quick decisions
- Requirement for CPR training
- Practical climbing exercises
- Practical pole top rescue training
- One worker rescue or two or more worker rescue

Course Requirements

This course is only for experienced climbers – 1 year minimum experience.

The client will need to provide:

- Climbing gear for each participant with body belt, pole belt and climbers (spurs)
- At least one set of tools, including a 2lb ball-peen hammer, skinning knife, 10" crescent wrench, and a few drive hooks (J-hooks)
- Provide a body belt for our dummy
- Polypropylene rope – twice the length of the pole plus 20' (at least 60-70') and least 3/8" diameter
- 1 pole, preferably framed with 7' crossarm, pins and braces
- Bucket truck to hoist dummy. If there is no bucket truck available then the instructor can bring his snatch block, but a truck is preferable.
- Classroom with a tv/vcr/dvd
