Through a combination of discussion, exercises and lecture, the course focuses on the role of supervisors in relation to legal requirements, occupational health and safety programs, effective leadership and risk assessment.

Course Objectives

Supervisors are the key to safety in a workplace. Often, the responsibility falls on them to communicate health and safety information between management and frontline workers.

This Safety Services Canada course aims to improve the supervisor's regard for a safety culture – specifically the safe knowledge, attitudes and behaviors of everyone in an organization.

Who Should Attend?

Manager's supervisors; lead hands/forman; safety committee members; anyone responsible for safety or loss control.
