

# TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS (TDG)

### Course Format - ½ Day

Safety Services New Brunswick offers a ½-Day **Transportation of Dangerous Goods** course utilizing audio-visual, handout materials and group discussions to deliver the information. This course meets the requirements for training under the Canadian Transportation of Goods Regulations and the Canadian Trucking Associations Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations - A Trucker Guide. Please note: this course applies to transporting dangerous goods by road only.

Each participant must complete a test either written or oral (80%). An APTA Employer and Employee certificate is issued upon successful completion. Maximum number of participants per session – 15.

#### **Course Objectives**

The program covers the TDG Act and Regulations as it pertains to land modes of transportation. The course is worker specific, made to emphasize all aspects of the act and regulations pertaining to the audience whether they are Shippers, Receivers, Couriers, Fork Lift Operators and Intermodal Transporters. Those working in proximity to dangerous goods and utilizing their Right to Know will benefit from this training.
