Participants will learn the regulations and reasons for establishing a committee, the role of the committee in the total safety program and best practices for committee meetings to maximize the function and scope of the committee. This course will also provide technical exercises in dealing with the assessment of **hazards & risks** as well as handling **incident investigations**.
