

SCAFFOLD SAFETY TRAINING

Course Format

Offered are both a ½-day refresher and a one-day Scaffold Safety Course. The course involves lecture, class discussion, audiovisuals and practical training. Participants will learn the regulations, inspection, care and maintenance of fall arrest equipment and scaffolds. The ½-day program is refresher for those who have had previous training/experience, and the one-day program involves theory and more practical applications. Prerequisite is a current Fall Protection certificate.

Maximum number of participants per session – 12.

- 3. Employees from all departments involved with scaffolding
